A local law to prohibit possession of open containers of Alcoholic Beverages.

Be enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Delaware as follows:

No person shall have in his or her possession within the Town of Delaware, an open or unsealed bottle or container of an alocoholic beverage, while such person is in any public place, including but not limited to any public highway, public street, public sidewalk, public alley, public parking lot or area, excepting locations licensed for the sale of alcoholic beverages by the State of New York, and any other area, when such area is being used with the written approval of the Toen authorities involved.

This law shall take effect immediately.

Conviction for violation of the above, as a first offense, shall be punishable by a fine of \$50.00.

Conviction for violation of the above, as a second offense, shall be punishable by a fine of \$100.00.

Conviction for violation of the above, as a third offense, shall be punishable by a fine of \$25000, an imprisonment and confinement in the County jail for a term not to excced 10 days.

This law shall take effect immeadiately.
