

INTRODUCTION OF LOCAL LAW #4-2020: FIXING SEWER RENTS FOR 2021:

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that Introductory Local Law #4 of the year 2020 entitled “A local law fixing sewer rent for the year 2021 in Sewer District No. 1 and Sewer District No. 2 of the Town of Delaware” is hereby introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Delaware, Sullivan County State of New York; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that copies of the aforesaid local law be laid upon the desk of each member of the Town Board; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hold a public hearing on said local law at the Town of Delaware Municipal Building, 104 Main Street, Hortonville, NY at 6:55 p.m. prevailing time, on November 11, 2020 and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town Board determines the proposed local law to be a Type II action pursuant to §617.5(C)(20) and (27) of the regulations of the Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act, for which no further environmental review is required; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk publish or cause to be published a public notice in the Sullivan County Democrat, of said public hearing at least five (5) days prior thereto.
